Unlimited golden score for all categories.

Fewer than 8 players will be pools. More than 8 players will be compound knockout and repechage. Some groups may be merged.

Any queries or disputes will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision is final. The competition will be run under BJA rules as per the Tournament Handbook. All players must wear a compliant white gi. Medals will be presented after the Junior Section and Senior Section.
