- Where possible, seeding and BJA Area separation will be made in the first round stage. Where numbers allow competition will be knockout with repechage.
- The Tournament director reserves the right to change to a system of pools, depending on the numbers.
- All contests will be 3 minutes in duration
- BJA rules will be strictly adhered to throughout the tournament.
- Clean White Judo

Please Note

- Where there are less than 4 in a category, the tournament director has the authority to combine weight groups. If there are insufficient numbers in age bands over 45 years, the tournament director has the authority to combine age bands.
- Proof of age will be required

Please produce a valid full BJA or an affiliated association judo licence when booking in.
