<b>Mode:</b>	<p><b><u>WHITE JUDOGI TO BE WORN</u></b></p> <p>Players will be check – weighed-in, on the day (at the venue) and will be placed into pools of three, four or five with players as close as possible to their own age/weight/grade and experience.</p> <p>The organisers will, where possible, separate players from the same school and club.</p> <p>All competitors will receive a medal. Medals will be awarded to players who win at least one contest</p> <p>Medals will be presented on the mat after the group finishes.</p> <p>This is a Level 2 Event.</p>
