Mode:	<p><u>WHITE JUDOGI WILL BE WORN</u></p> <p>Players will be check – weighed - in on the day (at the venue) and will be placed into pools of three, four or five with players as close as possible to their own age/weight/grade and experience.</p> <p>The organisers will, where possible, separate players from the same school and club.</p>

	<p>Competitors winning at least one fight will receive a medal. Medals will be presented after the group finishes on the mat.</p> <p><u>This is a Level 3 Point Scoring Event.</u></p> <p>Contest duration will be FOUR minutes.</p> <p>Shime-Waza and Kansetsu-waza WILL be allowed.</p> <p>If Scores are level at the end of the Contest, the players will go immediately into a Golden Score contest.</p> <p>There will be no time limit for Golden Score.</p> <p>The first score awarded will decide the winner.</p> <p>Conduct against the 'Spirit of Judo' will be penalised.</p>
