All competitors must hold a current BJA licence or licence of an association affiliated to the BJA, IJF, EJU and produce it on the day of the event; all players must be 8 and over on the day of the competition. Competition will be held on 1 or 2 matted areas depending on entries. Capacity 150 players. Best 3 clubs will receive Trophy Cup on the end of tournament- see information on the end of entry form.

WEIGHT CATEGORIES:

Group 1: A band age 8-11 **No armlocks and strangles allowed level 2**

A1: girls: no weight category- closest weights and grades go together max 5 per group
B2: boys: no weight category- closest weights and grades go together max 5 per group

Group 2: Pre cadets 2013-2014 **No armlocks and strangles allowed level 2**

B1: girls: no weight category- closest weights and grades go together max 5 per group
B2: boys: no weight category- closest weights and grades go together max 5 per group

Group 3: Cadets 2010-2011-2012 **(Armlocks and strangles allowed) level 3**

C1: females: U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, U70kg, U78 and plus 78kg
C2: : males: U50, U55, U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, U100kg and plus 100kg

Group 4: Seniors age 14+ **(Armlocks and strangles allowed) level 3**

S1: women: U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, U70kg, U78 and plus 78kg
S2: men: U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, U100kg and plus 100kg

Group 5: Veterans age 30+ **(Armlocks and strangles allowed) level 3**

M1: women: U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, U70kg, U78 and plus 78kg
M2: men: U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, U100kg and plus 100kg

Veterans aged groups will be followed by 10 years such as: 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70-79

Players over age 60 choke/ strangles prohibited in accordance with IJF rules.

Categories for groups 3-4-5 will be green belts under and blue belt above.

Weigh in: all judoka age must wear plain white T-shirt and judo trousers.

Group 5+4: 8.45am- 9.15am

Group 3+2: 10.45am- 11.15am Group 1: 12.30pm-1pm

Weigh in time may change for group 1, depending on entries received. Club will be informed if weigh in will be changed
