**Competition  
Format:**

This event is an age & grade banded event as follows:

**Under 12s - All Players aged between 8 & 11 on the day of the event.**

**British Judo Association Technical Restrictions Apply in this category.**

Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade & weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.

**Under 16s - All Players aged between 12 & 15 on the day of the event.**

**Arm locks or strangles are NOT ALLOWED in this category.**

Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade & weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.

**Seniors & Veteran Kyu Grades - All Players aged 14 & above; graded Novice to 2nd Kyu**

**The normal Judo rule set applies to this category.**

Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade & weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.

**Seniors & Veterans High Grade - All Players aged 14 & above; graded 1st Kyu & above.**

**The normal Judo rule set applies to this category.**

Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade & weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible. **NOT POINT SCORING**

As tournament organiser and with the agreement of the players & their coaches we reserve the right to combine the categories where necessary to provide our participants with meaningful contests.

This tournament aims to provide players with as much mat time as possible allowing them to gain more experience of competitive judo. All Players receive a medal.

To enter this event the Standard Entry Fee for this event is £25.

Double entries can also be made for the U16 & Senior Veteran categories as long as the entrant meets the age criteria for both events. Our double entry fee is £40.

These entry fees are applicable for all entries posted & paid for through our website on or before 11.59pm, Sunday 21st June 2026. Any entries made after this date will be charged at our late entry fee price of £30 for single entries or £50 for double entries.

We will accept entries on the day of the event of which our late entry fee of £30 will apply but payments must be made in cash.

We will only stop taking entries for this event if it becomes oversubscribed. If over-subscription occurs we will post a notice

**Weigh in:**

Players can weigh for Event 1 from 9am and weigh In times for all other events will be released after the closing date once we know how many are in each group.

All competitors **MUST** bring their **VALID** judo licence (BJA or affiliate) to registration and also their record book showing that they are at the grade in which they entered.

All players will be weighed in Judogi pants & t-shirt with 0.8kg allowance.

**Spectators:**

Entry Fee is £3 per adult paid cash on the day. Children are free and Coaches are free on presentation of a valid coaching card

**Coaching:**

Coaches will be allowed mat side throughout the day with a valid coaching pass.
