GROUPS:	Group 1 – Under 8 Festival Group 2 –Red and Yellow Belt Competition
TIMINGS:	Start: 09:30 am to 14:00 pm <u>See below for time slots</u>
FORMAT:	All players MUST be pre-weighed and will be grouped depending on gender, age, weight, COACH RATING and grade. All players will receive a medal/trophy.
PARICIPATION:	Players must hold a current BJA FULL membership
LEVEL:	This event is designed for beginners to give kids competition experience.
CONTEST RULES:	This is a development event. No shidos will be awarded, but referees may stop contests to explain rules and etiquette.
JUDOGI RULES:	Girls must wear a t-shirt under their judogi. Boys may opt to.
DURATION:	2 minute matches, no golden score
WEIGH-IN:	Please send judoka's weight and full details with your club entry below to info@a1judo.com On the day of the competition they will be weighed in again, timings for this will be emailed out by the organiser following entry close.
WEIGHING PROCESS:	Please weigh your judoka in their judo trousers and a t-shirt
ENTRY FEE:	£20 per player - Non-refundable unless the tournament is cancelled. Bank Transfer only – No payment on the day.
ENTRIES:	Please collate your club entry using the entry form details on page 2 and email to: info@a1judo.com Only full club Email entries with FULL DETAILS will be accepted
CLOSING DATE:	Closing date for entries when the entry limit is reached.
SPECTATORS:	£3.00 per adult spectator (16+). Children can spectate free of charge. Payable on the day.
COACHES:	Only one coach from each club per contest area will be allowed mat side. There will be no challenges to referees' decisions- this is a development and learning event for officials and Judoka- humility and respect are two of the judo moral code values- lets show these at all times.
