

## WESTCROFT JUDO CLUB (CIC) INVITATIONAL DEVELOPMENT EVENT SUNDAY 12 JULY 2026

- Development event For Boys & Girls SHO 5-7 YEARS, RED BELTS AGE 8 & 9 & RED & YELLOW BELTS AGE 10 & 11, on the day.
- Level one event, open only to clubs which have received an invitation.
- All players must have an up-to date Judo Licence/membership (BJA/BJC/AJA) and bring this along on the day with your record book and up to date grade information.
- Venue Club Dojo, CBSC Sports hall, Muschamp Road, Carshalton, SM5 2SU
- Free parking in CBSC sports hall car park or along Muschamp Road.
- Entry Fee £25 per player. No spectator fees
- Entry via participant only – no entries will be accepted after the closing date of Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July
- Please note that entry fees are not refundable, unless the event cancelled.
- Equipment: White Judogi, grade belt, t-shirt & zori (kits from other martial arts are not permitted)
- Method: Sho Festival pools 3, 4 or 5. Red & Red/Yellow Waterfall pool of 8 or pools of 3, 4 or 5. Competitors will be placed in groups according to age, weight & grade
- Registration times to be communicated before the event via your club coach.
- Weigh in: There will be no official weigh on the day.  
Each competitor is to be weighed first thing in the morning wearing Judo trousers and a T-shirt, please enter the **exact** weight in **KG** into the online entry form. We will carry out random weight checks on the day.
- Medals: All Sho players will receive the same medal. Red & Red/Yellow will receive medals according to placing, Gold, Silver & 2 Bronze medals & participation medals for the lower placings.
- Medal presentations as each pool finishes.
- This is a friendly development event as such: There will be no challenges to referee decisions, the referee in charge has the final decision. Mat side coaching is **not** permitted only positive encouragement. The aim is for an enjoyable day for all competitors, spectators, referees and club volunteers
- Welfare: Our CWO will be in attendance on the day.
