Judogi Rules	All competitors will wear a correctly fitting judogi, no BJJ, Karate or other martial arts gi. ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEIGH IN IN A T-SHIRT AND GI BOTTOMS (optional to fight in white t-shirts under judogi for boys, but girls must wear a t-shirt under the gi to fight. Please use the changing rooms to get changed)
Contest Rules	ALL categories will be run with the BJA rules. Contests shall be 4 mins for Kyu grades, 2 minutes for the festival. See BJA contest rules for details.
Competition Format	<p>Kyu grade competition: All competitors will be weighed on the day and grouped into Pools depending on gender, age, weight. We will try to group entries into pools with similar grades. All efforts will be made to find a suitable group for each competitor, the Tournament Director will consult coaches/players if any suitable matches can't be found (anyone without a group will be informed and refunded).</p> <p>Festival: Entries will be split into groups of different gender and similar weight. This is designed to be a fun event, with children able to experience randori style fighting, as well as some games.</p>
Weigh-in Times	Group 1: 9.00-9.30am Group 2/3: We will confirm the weigh in times approximately a week before the competition for each group. Please keep your eye on our facebook page and we will email everyone- please check your spam folder.
Spectators, coaches and officials.	Entry is free of charge for spectators, however, please remember this is a development event and it's about learning. Some of the referees and table officials will also be developing, so please bear with them. Remember children are watching your behaviour for examples how to behave. Seating is limited therefore be respectful of others and do not reserve with bags etc.
