Participation:	This is a Level 2 Development event for players 7th to 12th mon. The aim is to provide an opportunity for players to experience competition in an enjoyable environment. This will be an open weight competition where players will be sorted into suitable pools of 6 to 8 (where possible) on the day. When arranging the pools the Tournament Director will consider the age, weight and experience of the players. All players should be under 16 and over 8 years old on the day. This is for players graded 6 – 12 mon (to include top yellow belt players). This event is open to players who hold a current valid licence of the BJA or affiliated association. Players from affiliated associations should only hold a grade equivalent to BJA 6– 12 mon.
Competition Format:	Those with non-BJA grades should not hold grades above the colour stated. Blue judogi is not compulsory. All players must provide their own blue and white belts. Armlocks and Strangles will not be allowed. No technical restrictions will be used. Entries will be limited to 70 players and it is hoped the competition will be completed around 5.00pm.
Registration & Weigh In	Weigh-in times: All girls 9.00 - 9.30am. Boys under 50 kg 10.00 – 10.30am Boys over 50 kg 12.30 – 1.00pm
Closing Date:	Thursday 17 September 2026 or when the event is full.
Entry Fee:	£20 (no charge for spectators)
