All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo membership card and book to registration. The event has minimum grade criteria detailed below.</p> <p>International competitors must be the holder of a current membership and proof of grade recognised by their National Federation (IJF affiliate) and which must be produced on the day at registration.</p>

Players born in the years 2010 - 2012	<p>Minimum grade: Green Belt (10th Mon or 3rd Kyu)</p> <p>Contest Duration: 4 minutes</p>
Competition Format, Rules and Judogi Rules:	<p>The intended method of elimination for this event will be IJF/EJU Full Repechage for 8 players or more.</p> <p>British Judo Contest Rules will be in operation. Please note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No 30 second rule • Judogi measurements as per British Judo rules. • IJF Red label judogi rules or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be required at this event. <p>The wearing of both white judogi & blue judogi is not compulsory for this event. All competitors must have a white judogi available.</p> <p>Medals will be presented after each age band final contests have been completed. The Cadet event is a level 4 event, competitors must win at least one contest to be awarded a medal.</p> <p>This tournament qualifies for points scoring for grade promotion purposes.</p>
Seeding	Seeding will be taken from the latest rankings of the GB Cadet Identification Ranking (or equivalent).

	There will be no seeding for Pre-Cadet categories.

<p>Spectator Tickets:</p>	<p>Spectator entry will be available for advanced purchase via Welsh Judo website. Spectators will be required to demonstrate proof of purchase via mobile device on entry to the venue.</p> <p>Spectator tickets can be purchased online here</p> <p>Spectator entry purchased online will be charged £6.50 per person. Spectator entry purchased with cash will be charged at £10.00 per person. There will be no spectator charge for children (under 16).</p>
<p>Coaching Passes & Matside Coaching</p>	<p>Coaches must apply for a coaching accreditation pass by registering via www.welshjudo.com/coach-pcc/ by 23:59, Monday 19 October 2026.</p> <p>Coach registrations will be checked with British Judo or relevant governing body to confirm eligibility to coach matside at the event. Coaches must hold a minimum of Level 2 coaching qualification, or equivalent recognised by their governing body, in order to be eligible for matside coaching accreditation.</p> <p>Coaches must ensure that they attend the coaches briefing prior to the commencement of the event. The referee in charge will give a briefing on any updates.</p> <p>The event will be strictly adhering to the mat side coaching rule during the Cadet categories. In the following way: Coaches in the official mat side position can only advise the athlete during the mate-hajime period and not while the contest is in progress. Should any matside coach not adhere to this guideline they will firstly be reminded of this rule by the referee and on receiving the second reminder in the same contest will need to remove themselves to the general public area for the rest of the event on that day. Other personnel who insist on shouting coaching points will also need to remove themselves to the general public seating area.</p>
