<u>Group 6</u>	MALE	1st Dans Point Scoring*****
<u>Group 7</u>	MALE	2 nd Dans Point Scoring*****
<u>Group 8</u>	MALE	3 rd Dans & Above Point Scoring*****

Weighing In Times:

Groups 1 & 2	08.30AM to 09.00AM
Group 3 & 4 Only	10.30AM to 11.00AM
Groups 5-8	12.30PM to 13.00PM

Competitors must weigh in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and plain white T-shirt, BJA allowances will apply (0.8kg).

Method of Competition:

Competitors will be placed into pools based on their group and weight.

The aim is to give competitors as many contests as possible against people of the same grade and making as many opportunities as possible for point scoring for those relevant categories. Unfortunately, we are unable to allow participation without a valid full license nor are we able to refund entry fees.

High Wycombe Judo Centre has an on-site café and only food and drink purchased from our café is permitted to be consumed in our social area. No food or drink (only drinking water) is to be taken into the dojo.
