**Eligibility:** All BJA, BJC and AJA Clubs, players must be a minimum of 8yrs on the day and hold a full in date licence

**Entry Fee:** £20.00 with all profits raised split between the Royal British Legion, Help for Heroes and Blesma

£10 extra for dual entry into junior and senior event (14 & 15yr olds only)  
Spectators are free but donations are welcome

**Closing Date:** Monday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2026 unless full capacity reached beforehand

**Rules:** Four unique medals awarded for each weight group, participation medals for novice and red belts that finish outside of the top 4. Trophy for Juniors will be awarded to the club with the most accrued points (5 per gold medal, 3 per silver and 1 per bronze). Competitors should wear a white correctly fitting and clean judogi. All competitors MUST weigh in wearing a plain white round neck t-shirt. Girls MUST compete with a plain white round neck t-shirt, boys may also do so. No male competitors should be bare chested at any point, judogi changes MUST take place in the appropriate changing area. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries or combine weight and belt groups should this be required. Each club will be held responsible for the behaviour of its players. In the event of a dispute the Tournament Director's decision is final.
