**Eligibility:**

This is a Senior Open Point scoring event for judoka aged 14 years with groups catering for judokas graded from Nov - 2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu and a point scoring section for 1<sup>st</sup> Kyu and dan grades.

Competitors **MUST** produce a valid BJA or affiliated association membership card and record book at weigh in, failure to produce a valid membership card and proof of grade will mean no participation – no refund of entry fees.

**NO VALID LICENCE - NO CONTEST – NO EXCEPTIONS**

**Format:**

Players In Group A-F will fight in their weight groups and will receive medals for these groups, the tournament director reserves the right to combine or alter weight categories should entries dictate.

In the event of any dispute the decision of the tournament director will be final

**White JudoGi only.** Competitors are not allowed to change anywhere other than in changing rooms.

Only accredited coaches are allowed mat side when their players are competing and may be asked to produce their pass by any official.
