Eligibility:

Players must be **aged 8 years to 15 years on the date of event** and must comply with the following:

1. All competitors must hold a current valid full BJA license or an affiliated association licence. Any overseas competitors must hold their official governing body licence
2. Graded players must have attended a grading within the 6 months prior to the date of this event.
3. Novice players must have held a licence for no longer than 6 months prior to the date of this event.
4. All competitors are required to wear a standard white judo suit and girls to wear a **plain** white t-shirt underneath to compete.

Group A 8:30am-9am
Group C & E 11.30am-12pm
Group B,D & F 2pm-2.30pm

Please note - Weigh in times are subject to change depending on the entry split. We will communicate to everyone if there are any adjustments to the above times.

Method of Competition:

Technical restrictions will apply
Arm locks and strangles are not permitted
Judoka placed into pools of 4 or 5 based on closest weight and age

We will make every effort to ensure **that red belts and yellow belts are kept separate** throughout the pools to provide the best experience possible. Only in exceptional circumstances, such as where there are very limited entries in a particular age or weight bracket, may it be necessary to mix red and yellow belts. If this situation arises, we will discuss it with the relevant coaches before making any changes, so you can expect red and yellow belts to compete separately wherever possible, with mixed pools only being used as a very last resort.

Please Note

Please produce a valid full BJA or an affiliated association licence when booking in. Unfortunately we are not able to allow participation without a valid full licence nor are we able to refund entry fees.

High Wycombe Judo Centre has an on-site café and only food and drink purchased from our café is permitted to be consumed in our social area. No food or drink (only drinking water) is to be taken into the do-jo.
