- c) Competitors must wear suitable footwear at all times when off the mat.
- **d)** Points scoring~ Seniors & Youth where appropriate.
- e) First player called for a contest may a blue or white suit. Players wearing a white suit must wear a blue belt. Players wearing a blue suit may wear their grade belt. Players must provide their own belts
- f) Senior Players must be aged over 14 years of age and hold a Senior Licence
- g) Players may, if eligible, enter both the Senior Championships & Youth Championships.
- h) Any rules incorporated after the issue of this entry form will also apply

COACH ARENA PASS APPLICATION FORM

The BJA Midland Area committee has made special entry arrangements with the Walsall Campus management for coaches' entry to the arena floor.

If a coach wishes to be allowed access to the arena floor whilst his/her players are participating, the following rules must be observed:

1. Include £5.00 entrance fee with the completed application form.

A photocopy of your up to date coach accreditation card, and a stamped addressed envelope to the address below.

Note: any coach not in possession of an official coach pass. Or current BJA coach accreditation pass, will have to pay to enter the Walsall Campus as a spectator at a cost of £6.00. This will not allow access to arena floor
