

ADAPTIVE JUDO (ID – intellectual classification process)

British Adaptive judo provide competitions and training for all participants with a disability (<https://www.britishjudo.org.uk/gb-judo/gb-special-needs-judo/>) . For Intellectually Disabled judoka there are two additional competition pathways. SOGB – Special Olympics GB (<https://www.specialolympicsgb.org.uk/>) and ID Championships.

British Judo, European Home Nations and EJU are currently developing a performance pathway for ID athletes and with that a set criteria (INAS) that is required before consideration of selection to represent Great Britain at this level of event.

ID participants are required to have a registered IQ of 75 or below with currently a judo ability level of L1 – 2. (page 42 <https://www.britishjudo.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2016/07/British-Judo-Tournament-Handbook-v.8.pdf>)

UK Sports Association are the GB INAS representative who oversee the criteria and advise what information is required for full classification. <http://www.uksportsassociation.org/classification/athlete-classification-procedure/>

To begin the process applications must be completed in full. All information can be found on the UK Sports Association (above) links which enables you to download the relevant paperwork.

British Judo and EJU Home nations are currently utilising II1. For the future discussions for the inclusion of II2 & II3 to be considered.

The whole process of seeking a INAS IQ classification and registration is the sole responsibility of the parents/judoka. Without this registration process judoka are unable to be considered for GB selection into ID specific events.

Adaptive Judo will continue to provide a competition and training pathway for all levels of disability.
