



## NATIONAL SELECTION OF REFEREES

The National Refereeing Commission make the selection of referees to national events, home country opens, other major events and all VI and Adaptive judo events.

### Events

▪ Junior and Senior British Championships	All Referees
▪ British Schools Championships	All Referees
▪ All VI Events	All Referees
▪ All SN/ID Events	All Referees
▪ National Teams	8 referees per event
▪ National Masters	8 referees per event
▪ British Minors Championships	8 referees per event
▪ English Open (all types)	8 referees per event
▪ Scottish Open (all types)	8 referees per event
▪ Welsh Open (all types)	8 referees per event
▪ Northern Ireland Open (all types)	8 referees per event

### Selection Process

- The organiser shall send their list of the proposed referees to the NRC Secretary 4 months prior to the event. This list must meet the minimum referee level and number standards for the level of the event.
- The NRC will provide a list of selected referees and some reserves to the organiser; it is the event organiser's responsibility to call these referees.
- Any NRC selections to be amended by the organiser must be approved in writing prior to the event.
- The NRC reserves the right to amend any of the selections prior to the event.

### Costs and Expenses

- All costs and expenses for selected referees are to be borne by the event and are not the responsibility of the NRC.
- In turn, NRC will make reasonable efforts to ensure that selected referees are cost effective to the organisation.
