



2019 Commonwealth Judo Championships JudoEngland Pre-Cadet Information Sheet

It is an open entry for Pre-Cadets to represent England at the 2019 Commonwealth Judo Championships on Saturday 28th September 2019 at the University of Wolverhampton, Walsall Campus.

Please note:

- This is a SELF-FUNDED opportunity with an entry fee of £75.00 for athletes
- Official weigh-in will be at the venue on Friday 27th September 2019 from 15:30 to 17:00
- Competition day is Saturday 28th September 2019
- White Judogi ONLY are required and must meet the standard IJF Regulations - Sokutei will be used on the day
- Backpatches are not mandatory but if worn **MUST** display **ENG NOT GBR**. ENG patches will be available for purchase, advice on how to obtain them will be communicated shortly

Eligibility

- All competitors must be born in the years 2005/2006
- Weight categories:
 - Girls: -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, u70kg, +70kg
 - Boys: -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, 46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, +73kg
- England players must have a British Passport/Birth Certificate
- England players must complete an In-Loco-Parentis Form

Coaching Overview

1. Coach Accreditation

1. Players will be asked to name their coach and advise an email address at point of registering for the tournament
2. Coaches will be contacted directly with a link to complete their registration



2. Matside Coaching

1. All club coaches will be allowed matside access to coach Pre-Cadets. However only accredited coaches will be given access. Therefore it is imperative that club players name their coach at point of entry.
2. Please refer to the expected coaching behaviours laid out in the tournament outlines.

3. Coaches Dress Code

1. Coaches should wear club tracksuits matside for the preliminary rounds of the competition. Smart attire (suit) is required for the final block as stated in the tournament outlines
