One coach, who must remain seated is allowed per competitor  The wearing of white and blue judogi is not compulsory for this event  The CARE system will not be in operation for this event  Medals will be presented as soon as the weight category is completed, and the necessary paperwork is available  This is a level three points scoring tournament. BJA rules will apply throughout the event and will be in accordance with the BJA Tournament Handbook  The decision of the Tournament Director will be final
