

## **LONDON AREA DEVELOPMENT EVENT**

**Saturday 22 January 2022**

### **Eligibility:**

This is a development event and the event is limited to young players, over 8 years old and under 16 years old, novice to 9<sup>th</sup> mon.

Competitors **MUST** produce a valid BJA or affiliated association membership card and record book when booking in, failure to produce a valid membership card and proof of grade will mean no participation – no refund of entry fees.

### **Covid Guidelines**

Once you arrive at the venue, you will be asked to provide evidence of your negative test result (unless exempt) which can be accessed on your COVID Pass via the NHS App or via an email or text from the NHS COVID-19 notification service.

**All spectators and visitors** will be required to show their proof of a negative test upon arrival at the venue. Please be prepared to show your COVID pass at any time during the event.

**All visitors** aged 11 and over must take and report a rapid lateral flow test (LFD test) no earlier than 24 hours prior to arrival at the venue, regardless of your vaccination status.

Where a lateral flow test cannot be taken due to an exemption, this should be demonstrated through your [NHS COVID Pass](#) e.g., if you have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days.

Face coverings will be mandatory in all areas of the venue, at all times. Where worn correctly, face coverings and masks can reduce the risk of transmission.

All persons present in the venue must wear a face covering, except in particular cases:

- Competitors and referees on the contest tatami
- Face coverings/masks may only be removed whilst eating and drinking in a seated area

There are no exceptions to the face covering rule, other than medical exemption.

- The coach must wear a face covering/mask in the competition area at all times, this includes whilst being in the coaching box during a contest
- All visitors must wear a face covering/mask when seated in the spectator stands, only removing to eat or drink
- All officials must wear face covering/mask unless refereeing on the tatami
- All staff members must wear a face covering/mask at all times

**Format:**

Players will be grouped into pools of 4/5 players of their weight, where possible, based on the age/grade groups below. However, some groups may need to be merged, and in these instances, it will discuss with the coaches of the affected players.

It is imperative that you put players EXACT weight in KG's on the entry form prior to the event.

Please ensure there is a contact email address for any queries to be resolved prior to the event.

White Judogi only. Competitors are not allowed to change anywhere other than in changing rooms.

Medals will be presented after each group, where possible, and all competitors will receive an award for competing.

Only accredited coaches are allowed mat side when their players are competing and may be asked to produce their pass by any official.

GROUP 1 – Novice – 2 Mon (aged 8 to 11 yrs on the day of the event)  
GROUP 2 – Novice – 2 Mon (aged 12 to 15 yrs on the day of the event)

GROUP 3 – 3 Mon – 5 Mon (aged 8 to 11 yrs on the day of the event)  
GROUP 4 – 3 Mon – 5 Mon (aged 12 to 15 yrs on the day of the event)

GROUP 5 – 6 Mon – 9 Mon (aged 8 to 11 yrs on the day of the event)  
GROUP 6 – 6 Mon – 9 Mon (aged 12 to 15 yrs on the day of the event)

Contest Times: All Contests 3 Minutes Duration

Weigh-in Times: All Girls Groups 08:30 to 09:15  
Boys Groups 1, 3 & 5 : 09:30 to 10:00  
Boys Groups 2, 4 & 6 : 11:00 to 11:30

Entry Fee: £20.00 per entry

Spectators Fee: £3.00 per adult (to be paid on entrance to the hall).  
**Coaches will be allowed free entry on production of their valid accredited coaching pass.**
