(all Cadets may also compete in the Junior category) Seniors: Year of birth – Minimum age of 14 years – Contest time 4 mins. Masters: Year of birth – Minimum age of 30 years – Contest time 3 mins. Minimum grade – Green Belt All competitors must bring their judo licence to the weigh-in to confirm grade and eligibility. It is the competitor's responsibility to check that their licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete. |

This includes the amalgamation of age categories in the Masters categories depending on the number of entries.</p> |
| <p>Registration & Weigh-In</p> | <p>The official registration and weigh-in will take place –</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sunday 10th April 2022</u></p> <p>Juniors - 8.30am to 9am (Test Scales available) Seniors & Masters - 11am to 11.30am (Test Scales available)</p> <p><u>Please note:</u> Juniors who are competing in both Junior & Senior categories should collect both their Junior and Senior registration cards and weigh in during the allocated Junior weigh in time.</p> <p>Players must weigh-in wearing underwear and will receive a 0.1kgs weight allowance. Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, ie for U73kg must weigh over 66.1kg.</p> <p>All Cadets who competed on the Saturday and are competing in the Junior event on the Sunday <u>must register and weigh-in for the Junior event</u> during the allocated times but they will not be required to make their weight category limit but should be within 5% of the maximum weight limit for their weight category.</p> <p>Please note: No changes of weight category will be permitted after the player has weighed in on the official scales.</p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo licence (BJA or affiliate) to registration and also their record book showing they meet the minimum grade requirement.</p> <p>The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area.</p> |
