## British Kata Championships 2022

**Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> September 2022**

Samurai Judo Club, Zortech Avenue, Kidderminster DY11 7DY

As with the last British Kata Championships in 2019 before the pandemic, this event is being held with much greater emphasis on development and feedback. We want to make this a more friendly, welcoming event where players enter to improve their skills. The 2019 event was very popular, with an entry three times as large as the previous event.

All kata will gain a final overall score, which will be published.

After the end of the event, judges will be allocated to pairs to give feedback. Selected adult players of very high standard and experience may be invited to assist in judging the youth section and/or feedback to pairs in the youth section.

### Categories

#### ADULTS:

Nage-no-kata

Katame-no-kata

Gonosen-no -kata

Ju-no-kata

Kodokan Goshin-jutsu

Kime-no-kata

#### YOUTH (Under 16 years on the day):

Nage-no-kata

Katame-no-kata

Ju-no-kata

Youth Players wishing to present other kata may enter adult sections.

### Limitations to Youth kata:

1. Nage-no-kata: first 3 sets only.
2. Katame-no-kata: first two sets only.
3. Ju-no-kata: first set only.

### Weigh-In

All adult kata: 9.00-9.30 am

Youth kata: 1.00-1.30 pm

### Standards

The standards for all kata except Gonosen-no-kata are the Kodokan videos.

Gonosen-no-kata: any recognisable version may be presented. See next page for full details.

### Marking

Each technique will be scored out of 10. The score will be given for effectiveness of technique and compliance to kata standard. A technique omitted will score zero. There will be additional marks out of 10 for opening and closing etiquette. The EJU marking system will not be used.

The club will be available on the day before, 10 am to 4 pm, for any pairs wishing to orient themselves and do some last practice. Judges will be around later on that day to give last-minute advice. ### Gonoson-no-kata

This is in the nature of a free kata and so any recognisable version may be presented.

Opening and closing etiquette should be similar to Nage-no-kata and Katame-no-kata. The player performing the counter-technique begins to the right of the judges.

Demonstration of techniques should generally take place in the centre of the area, ie within 2m of the centre of the mat area, but precise foot patterns, positions and directions are up to the players.

#### Set One

1. O-soto-gari countered by O-soto-gaeshi
2. Hiza-guruma countered by Hiza-guruma
3. O-uchi-gari countered by Nidan-ko-soto-gari
4. De-ashi-barai countered by Tsubami-gaeshi
5. Ko-soto-gake countered by Tai-otoshi
6. Ko-uchi-gari countered by Sasae-tsurikomi-ashi

#### Set Two

7. Tsurikomi-goshi countered by Ushiro-goshi
8. Koshi-guruma countered by Uki-goshi
9. Hane-goshi countered by Sasae-tsurikomi-ashi
10. Harai-goshi countered by Utsuri-goshi
11. Uchi-mata countered by Uchi-mata-sukashi
12. Ippon-seoinage countered by Sumi-gaeshi

There are three different options:

#### OPTION 1

1. Player one throws with the initial throw (eg ippon-seoinage on the last move).
2. Player one attacks and player two counters in "slow motion", which actually simply means noticeably slower than at normal speed.
3. Player one attacks and player two counters at normal speed.

#### OPTION 2

Just parts 1 and 3 from Option 1 above, ie omitting the slower part.

#### OPTION 3

Just part 3, ie player one attacks and player two counters at normal speed.

Players may choose which option they wish to present. There is no advantage or disadvantage in marking terms for any option.

However, please inform us which option you intend to present when entering or by email so that we can be fully prepared.

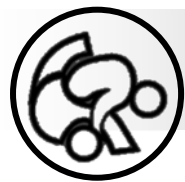
