Group 4 :	Senior (14 years or older) , 1st Kyu's and above BJA Level three point scoring competition Weigh In Women 12:30 to 13:00, Men 13:15 to 13:45

<p>Competition Format</p> <p>8 to 15 years:</p>	<p>Players will be weighed on the day and will be placed into pools of three, four or five with players as close as possible to their own age/weight/grade and experience.</p> <p>Where possible players from same club will be separated.</p> <p>Each competitor will receive a bespoke "British Judo Northern Area" Medal.</p>  <p>Group 1 - 8 to 15 years, Novice to 6th Mon (Yellow)</p> <p>Contest duration will be 3 minutes.</p> <p>Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza will not be allowed.</p> <p>The winner will be determined by Scores, and then Penalties.</p> <p>If the players are level at the end of the contest time the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority.</p> <p>BJA Under 12 Technical Restrictions will apply. Throwing Techniques such as the following will not score and may be penalised: - Tomoe-Nage, Sumi-Gaeshi, Drop Seoi-Nage, Kube-Nage.</p> <p>Group 2 - 8 to 15 years, 7th Mon to 15th Mon (Blue)</p> <p>Contest duration will be 3 minutes.</p> <p>Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza will not be allowed.</p> <p>If Scores are level at the end of the Contest, the players will go immediately into a 3 minute Golden Score contest. Scores and Penalties will be carried forward.</p> <p>If the players are level at the end of the golden score time the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority.</p>
<p>Weighing Policy:</p>	<p>There will be an 'Open Weigh-in' Players must wear competition legal Judogi trousers. Female players must also wear a regulation T Shirt. An allowance of 0.5kg Male and 0.6kg Female is made. Times are subject to change once entries received, which will be advised to all in advance.</p>

Scores and Penalties will be carried forward.</p> <p>If the players are level at the end of the golden score time the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority.</p> <p>Group 4 - 14 years or older, 1st Kyu's and above</p> <p>This is a Level 3 Point Scoring Event</p> <p>Contest duration will be 4 minutes.</p> <p>Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza will be allowed.</p> <p>If Scores are level at the end of the Contest, the players will go immediately into a Golden Score contest. Scores and Penalties will be carried forward.</p> <p>There will be no time limit for Golden Score.</p>
<p>Weighing Policy:</p>	<p>There will be an 'Open Weigh-in' Players must wear competition legal Judogi trousers. Female players must also wear a regulation T Shirt. An allowance of 0.5kg Male and 0.6kg Female is made. Times are subject to change once entries received, which will be advised to all in advance.</p>
