Level:	British Judo Association Level One Competition.
Participation:	Boys and Girls who are a minimum of 8 years old up to and including 15 years old on the day. Competitors must be members of the British Judo Association, or British Judo Council or Amateur Judo Association. Competitors must be Novice to 6 th Mon (Yellow belt) maximum.
Mode:	Players will be check-weighed-in on the day (at the venue) and will be placed into pools of three, four or five with children as close as possible to their own age/weight/grade and experience. The organisers will, where possible, separate players from the same school and club. Each competitor will receive a participation certificate. Each pool winner will receive a medal. Medals/Certificates will be presented on the mat after each group finishes in reverse order up to overall winner. This is a Level 2 Development Event. Contest duration will be three minutes. Please note that these contests may be refereed by one referee only. Junior Referees may be deployed. Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza will not be allowed.

	<p>The winner will be determined by Scores, and then Penalties.</p> <p>If the players are level on Scores and Penalties at the end of the contest the players will immediately start a 3-minute Golden Score contest. Scores and Penalties will be carried forward.</p> <p>The first score or penalty awarded will decide the winner.</p> <p>If the players are level on Scores and Penalties at the end of the Golden Score contest, the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority.</p> <p>BJA Under 12 Technical Restrictions will apply. Throwing Techniques such as the following will not score and may be penalised: - Tomoe-Nage, Sumi-Gaeshi, Drop Seoi-Nage, Kube-Nage.</p> <p>A referee may call Ippon if the player is in a hold down and they are satisfied it is best to do so for safety or medical reasons. Coaches are encouraged to help prepare their players to be ready to compete promptly; for example, by helping with belts etc.</p>
Weigh – in:	0900hrs to 0945hrs
Weighing In Policy:	<p>The British Judo Association weigh-in policy will be operated.</p> <p>Boys must wear Judogi trousers when weighing-in. Tolerance to 0.5kg (500 grams) i.e., 34.5 etc Girls must wear Judogi trousers and a regulation T-Shirt when weighing-in. Tolerance of 0.6kg (600 grams) i.e., 36.6 etc.</p>

Entry Fee:	£17.00
Spectators:	Free – All coaches and spectators.
Preamble:	There will be a presentation on the rules of the competition – 1000hrs.
