Participation:	<p>Boys and Girls who are a minimum of 8 years old up to and including 15 years old on the day.</p> <p>Competitors must be members of the British Judo Association, or British Judo Council or Amateur Judo Association.</p> <p>Competitors must be a minimum of Orange belt and a maximum of Blue belt.</p>
Mode:	<p>Players will be check-weighed-in, on the day (at the venue) and will be placed into pools of three, four or five with children as close as possible to their own age/weight/grade and experience. The organisers will, where possible, separate players from the same school and club.</p> <p>Each competitor will receive a participation certificate.</p> <p>Each pool winner will receive a medal.</p> <p>Medals/Certificates will be presented on the mat after each group finishes.</p>

	<p>This is a Level 2 Event.</p> <p>Contest duration will be three minutes. Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza will not be allowed.</p> <p>The winner will be determined by Scores and then Penalties. If the players are level on Scores and Penalties at the end of the contest the Players will immediately start a 3 minute Golden Score Contest Scores and Penalties will be carried forward. The first score or penalty awarded will decide the winner.</p> <p>If the scores and penalties are level at the end of the Golden Score contest, the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority.</p> <p>Conduct against the 'Spirit of Judo' will be penalised.</p>
Weigh-in:	1130hrs to 1200hrs.
Weighing in Policy:	<p>It will be an 'Open Weigh-in' Boys must wear Judogi trousers when weighing-in. Tolerance to 0.5kg (500 grams) i.e., 34.5 etc Girls must wear Judogi trousers and a regulation T-Shirt when weighing-in. Tolerance of 0.6kg (600 grams) i.e., 36.6 etc.</p>
