<b>Level:</b>	British Judo Association Level Two Competition.
<b>Participation:</b>	<p>Male and Female players who are a minimum of 14 years and older.</p> <p>Competitors must be members of the British Judo Association, or British Judo Council or Amateur Judo Association.</p> <p>Competitors must be Novice to Blue belt maximum.</p>
<b>Mode:</b>	<p>Players will be check – weighed-in, on the day (at the venue) and will be placed into pools of three, four or five with players as close as possible to their own age/weight/grade and experience.</p> <p>The organisers will, where possible, separate players from the same school and club.</p> <p>Each competitor will receive a participation certificate.</p> <p>Medals/Certificates will be presented on the mat after each group finishes.</p> <p>Each pool winner will receive a medal.</p> <p>This is a Level 2 Event.</p> <p>Contest duration will be three minutes.</p> <p>Please note that these contests may be refereed by one referee only.</p> <p>Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza will be allowed.</p>

	<p>The winner will be determined by Scores and then Penalties. If the players are level on Scores and Penalties at the end of the contest the Players will immediately start a 3-minute Golden Score Contest.</p> <p>Scores and Penalties will be carried forward.</p> <p>The first score or penalty awarded will decide the winner.</p> <p>If the scores and penalties are level at the end of the Golden Score contest, the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority.</p> <p>Conduct against the 'Spirit of Judo' will be penalised.</p>
<b>Weigh-in:</b>	1300hrs to 1330hrs
<b>Weighing in Policy:</b>	<p>It will be an 'Open Weigh-in'</p> <p>Male players must wear Judogi trousers when weighing-in. Tolerance to 0.5kg (500 grams) i.e., 80.5 etc</p> <p>Female players must wear Judogi trousers and a regulation T-Shirt when weighing-in. Tolerance of 0.6kg (600 grams) i.e., 70.6 etc.</p>
<b>Contest Start:</b>	1400hrs – Approximately.
<b>Entry Fee:</b>	£17.00
<b>Spectators:</b>	<b>FREE</b> – All coaches and spectators.
