# 7.1 Chairman's Report

Ronnie Saez (RS) thanked everyone for their attendance.

RS then provided an overview of highs and lows of the previous year:

- Very difficult period due to Covid-19 but we are now entering a recovery phase. Need to support our clubs in reopening and building up their membership again
- There have been 6 changes to the Board membership, which equates to 50%. Also, thanks to be noted to the departing/departed Board Directors who have served on the Board for 7/8 years and provided excellent support and advice to RS as Chair
- Our funding partners, UK Sport and Sport England, are being extremely supportive and allow us flexibility with allocating our funding across the Association
- Congratulations to be noted for our Olympic and Paralympic medal winners and to the clubs and coaches that have supported them along with the whole Performance Team
- Personal tribute to GK for his services to judo and to British Judo in his Presidential role and wished him a long and happy retirement.
   However, GK would be remembered in a President Emeritus role

RS then introduced RBi as the new BJA President.

RBi thanked RS and the rest of the judo family present for their support not only through the election but throughout life, adding that she was extremely honoured to be taking on the President role. RBi added that she looked forward to engaging with clubs and members and would serve British Judo to the best of her abilities.

# 7.2 Chief Executive's Report

Andrew Scoular (AS) opened that he was disappointed to not be in attendance at the AGM or Awards Dinner due to Covid-19.

AS shared his presentation and highlighted the following points:

- Work is continuing on the Strategy for 2022 to 2025 which will be accompanied by an action plan with clear targets
- Equality, Diversity and Inclusion Steering Group has been established
- Performance Team returned to competition in January 2021 and focused on qualifying for the Olympic & Paralympic Games
- Both Sally Conway and Alice Schlesinger retired
- Due to Covid-19, 15 staff were furloughed and had to close the Destination Judo programme
- Membership income was down by 77% and gradings by 96%
- Ran a series of social media campaigns to keep members engaged and created a Covid-19 Hub on the website
- Online education and training courses were run for referees and officials
- Extensive guidance was produced for clubs for "A Safe Return to Judo"
- Launched SE Club Support Grant to provide financial support for clubs to reopen
