	Event 4 - Under 20s (Players aged 14-19, Full BJA Contest Rules Apply)
	Event 5 - Seniors (Players aged 14 & above, Full BJA Contest Rules Apply)
	Event 6 - Senior No-Gi (Players aged 14 & above, Rashguard/T-shirt, Shorts & Belt. BJA No-Gi Contest Rules Apply)
	Across all the age categories players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade, weight & competition experience with the aim to create meaningful contests and provide fighters with as much contest time as possible.
	As tournament organiser and with the agreement of the players & their coaches we reserve the right to combine the categories where necessary to provide our participants with meaningful contests.
	This tournament aims to provide players with the opportunity to gain as much experience within their permitted competitive rule sets as possible. With this in mind all players aged 14 and above can double and possibly triple enter at a discounted price to fight in more than one age category as long as they meet the criteria I.E. u16, u20.
	All players will receive a medal in all categories.
