Competition Format:	<p>This event is an age & grade banded event as follows:</p> <p>Event 1 - Under 12s (aged 8-11 on the day of the event.) Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade & weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible. All Players will receive a medal</p> <p>Event 2 - Under 16s (aged 12-15 on the day of the event.) Male Weight Classes -42kg -46kg -50kg -55kg -60kg -66kg -73kg -81kg +81kg Female Weight Classes -32kg -36kg -40kg -44kg -48kg -52kg -57kg -63kg +63kg Format: 6> Entries - Single Pool. 7< Pools to Knockout. 1 Gold, 1 Silver & 2 Bronzes awarded per category.</p> <p>Event 3 - Senior Low Grades (Players aged 14 & above) Novice to 2nd Kyu Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade & weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible. All Players will receive a medal</p> <p>Event 4 - Seniors High Grades (Players aged 14 & above) 1st Kyu & Above Male Weight Classes -60kg -66kg -73kg -81kg -90kg +90kg Female Weight Classes -48kg -52kg -57kg -63kg -70kg +70kg Format: 6> Entries - Single Pool. 7< Pools to Knockout. 1 Gold, 1 Silver & 2 Bronzes awarded per category.</p> <p>As tournament organiser and with the additional agreement of the players & their coaches we reserve the right to combine the categories where necessary to provide our participants with meaningful contests.</p>

<p>Weigh in:</p>	<p>To make our event as efficient as possible we will wait until Wednesday 10th April 2024 to analyse our entry and make an informed decision on when to stage the weigh in times for each event. We will email the confirmed weigh in times to all competitors using the email address they provided us upon entering. We will also post the weigh in times on our social media channels & website.</p> <p>We envisage the start of contests at 9.30am</p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo license (BJA or affiliate) to registration and also their record book showing that they are at the grade in which they entered.</p> <p>ALL players will be weighed in Judogi pants & t-shirt with fighters u66kg /u63kg & below</p>
