Yellow, Orange & Green Belt U16 Championships

VENUE:	The Herts and Essex Sports Centre, Beldams Lane, Bishops Stortford, Hertfordshire. CM23 5LH
PARTICIPATION:	Competitors must hold a current BJA or affiliate membership. Competitors must be aged between 8 and 15 years on the day of the event. Minimum grade 4th Mon/ 5th Kyu , maximum grade 12th Mon/ 3rd Kyu .
GROUPS:	Group 1 – Girls 8 to 11yrs: Yellow, Orange & Green Belts (4th to 12th Mon): -28kg, -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, +52kg Group 2 – Girls 12 to 15yrs: Yellow, Orange & Green Belts (4th to 12th Mon/ 5th to 3rd Kyu): -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, +63kg Group 3 – Boys 8 to 11yrs: Yellow, Orange & Green Belts (4th to 12th Mon): -27kg, -30kg, -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, +50kg Group 4 – Boys 12 to 15yrs: Yellow, Orange & Green Belts (4th to 12th Mon/ 5th to 3rd Kyu): -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, +66kg
REGISTRATION & WEIGH IN:	Groups 1 & 2: Girls: 9:00am Group 4: Boys 12-15yrs: 11:00am Group 3: Boys 8-11yrs: 12:00noon All competitors must bring their valid judo membership card to registration along with their record book which shows they meet the age and grade requirements. All competitors will take part in an open weigh in, wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and crew neck t-shirt/ rash guard. Please note weight-in times may be modified to minimise time between weigh-in and competing. In the event of a change all entrants will be notified at least one week before the event.
EVENT FORMAT:	Top 4 placed competitors will receive a medal. The method of elimination for this event will be compound knockout with double repechage for 8 competitors or more, 7 competitors or less will be pools. Contest durations will be 3 minutes for all groups. Dependent on the entry some groups may be merged, this will be at the discretion of the tournament director and club coaches.
CONTEST RULES:	Current BJA rules will be in operation. BJA Technical Restrictions will apply in groups 1 and 3.
JUDOGI RULES:	Competitors must wear a white judogi (blue judogi not permitted). Girls must wear a plain white crew neck t-shirt/ rash guard, boys may opt to.
PHOTOGRAPHY/ FILMING:	By entering the event, all participants and parents or guardians of participants are consenting to photography/filming at the event. You also accept that these photographs or video may be used in by the event organisers.
ENTRY FEE:	£25.00 per competitor - Non-refundable unless tournament is cancelled.

SPECTATORS:	Free.
COACHES:	Coaches must produce a valid BJA Coach Award Card (reflecting matside privileges) to gain matside access (only one coach per contest area will be permitted matside at any one time).
