Armlocks and strangles are permitted throughout the event.

Method of Competition	Pools. Pools/Crossover where appropriate. The Tournament Director reserves the right to combine or alter categories should entries dictate. Priority of age and grade will be considered where possible. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Director will be final.
Registration & Weigh In	Section A – Weigh in – 8.30 to 9.00am contest starting approx. 9.30. Section B & C – Weigh in – 10:00 to 10:45am contest start 11.30 or earlier. All competitors MUST present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers. Females must wear a plain white round neck t-shirt for weigh-in and competing. Weight allowance of 0.8kg with t-shirt, 0.7kg with judogi trousers +18yrs of age.
Medals	Gold, Silver, Bronze, Bronze. In a pooled weight division, judoka must have won a contest to receive a medal.
General	Photographs may also be taken for promotional purposes including publication on club websites. By completing an entry form you indicate your acceptance of these conditions and parents (in the absence of any expressed objection) provide their consent to the taking and use of photos/videos. NO Flash photography. The event is run in line with BJA Child Protection Policy The wearing of BLUE & WHITE judogi is not compulsory at this event.
