Weight/Grade Categories:	<p>Weight All competitors will be weighed in and categories will be made to suit pools where possible.</p> <p>Categories -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg -100kg, +100kg -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg</p> <p>Novice (white belt) to 5th kyu (yellow belt) 4th kyu (orange belt) to 2nd kyu (blue belt)</p> <p>NOTE: Weights/categories may be combined based on entry.</p>

Rules:	<p>General: British Judo Association Contest Rules will apply all other rules according to the British Judo Association Tournament Handbook for a level 2 event.</p> <p>Judogi: Competitors may compete in any colour of judogi as long as it fits in accordance with the current BJA contest rules on judogi control. Players should bring their own blue & white belts if possible.</p> <p>All players may opt to wear a t-shirt under their judogi. The t-shirt must comply with the current BJA judogi control rules, although non-white t-shirts will be accepted.</p> <p>Technical Restrictions: Novice to 5th Kyu – No strangles & Armlocks No other technical restrictions will apply</p> <p>Coaching: Permitted through out and positive encouragement for all players is welcome.</p>
Weigh-In:	<p>Weigh-in times to be announced after event closing.</p> <p>We highly recommend novice to 5th kyu players attend early to watch the 4th kyu to 2nd kyu categories.</p> <p>Weigh-in will be open with the following new allowances. All competitors must wear contest judogi trousers to weigh-in.</p> <p>A Saturday weigh-in will be available for players who help lay the mats.</p> <p>0.7kg for competitors wearing judogi trousers only 0.8kg for competitors wearing judogi trousers and a t-shirt</p> <p>Entry list & timetable will be posted on www.scottishstudentsport.com/sports/judo/ after the closing date.</p>
Officials	<p>Trainee officials will be used for this event under supervision. Please be conscious of this and make every effort to encourage their participation. Any player not eligible to compete is welcome to try refereeing/timekeeping on the day, please let us know in advance if you are bringing any such players.</p> <p>Special note for Scottish Student clubs: Referee / Table Official training is available through the judo chair at Scottish Student Sport.
