### Categories

GROUP A: Girls Red Belts

GROUP B: Girls Yellow & Orange belts

Group C: Ladies blue belt & Under

Group D: Men orange belt & Under

PLEASE NOTE: If you are an experienced BJJ player or similar but have no judo grade, please email us to discuss.

### Weigh-In

All weigh-in times will be posted on the club website and Facebook page a week before the event or when we have all the entries in. The first weigh-in will not start until 9.30 am.

Players weigh in wearing judogi bottoms and a t-shirt.

There are no weight categories. All players will be sorted into groups by weight, age and grade.

Group A will be single pools with all players receiving a medal

Groups B-D will be twin pools into semi-final and final.

### Notes

All competitors must have a current BJA licence or equivalent.

Groups A & B must be under 16 years old (minimum age 8).

Groups C & D must be minimum of 14 years old on the day.

Group A: Level One event. Groups B-D: Level Two event.

BJA Technical Restrictions apply in Group A. Strangles and armlocks allowed in Groups C & D only.

Players who qualify can enter both groups B and C. This can be done on the day (no extra charge).

### Entry

Entry fee: £17 per player; £20 if entered in advance but paid on the day. NO entries on the day.

Spectators free.

Closing date for entries: May 2 or when event is full. This event will be oversubscribed, so early entry is advised.
