Groups <i>(All ages relate to the day of competition)</i>	<p>Group 1: Boys Novice to Red age 8-11</p> <p>Group 2: Boys Yellow to Orange aged 8-11</p> <p>Group 3: Boys Novice to Red and Yellow to Orange aged 12-16</p> <p>Group 4: Men Novice to Red and Yellow to Orange age 15 plus</p> <p>Group 5: Men Novice to Red and Yellow to Orange aged 15 plus (Technical restrictions)</p>
Participation	All competitors MUST hold a current BJA, BJC or AJA license. NO LICENSE NO JUDO! Players must have graded within the last 9 months.
Judogi Rules	<p>All competitors will wear a judogi; BJJ and Karate etc uniforms will not be accepted.</p> <p>ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEIGH IN IN A T-SHIRT AND GI BOTTOMS (optional to fight in white t-shirts under judogi, please use the changing rooms to get changed)</p> <p>All Judogi must fit correctly.</p>
Contest Rules	<p>ALL boy's categories will be run with technical restrictions.</p> <p>Contests shall be 3mins for under 16's.</p> <p>See BJA contest rules for details.</p>
Competition Format- Boys	<p>All competitors will be weighed on the day and grouped into Pools depending on age, weight, and grade. Using the index system (Age x2+grade+weight). All efforts will be made to find a suitable group for each competitor, the Tournament Director will consult coaches/parents if any suitable matches can't be found (anyone without a group will be informed and refunded).</p> <p>Novices and red belts will be separated from yellow and orange belts.</p> <p>If required age groups may be merged (within reason), coaches and competitors will be consulted the week of the competition date of any issues.</p>
Competition format- Seniors	<p>Contests shall be 4min in the Senior categories.</p> <p>Group 5 will be run with technical restrictions (no drops, armlocks or strangles) as a trial. The hope is to encourage some people into competing that may be concerned about injuries. (Group 4 will be run as a normal adult comp)</p> <p>See BJA contest rules for details.</p>
Weigh-in Times	<p>Groups 1 0900hrs – 0930hrs</p> <p>Group 2 1100hrs – 1130hrs</p> <p>Groups 3,4&5 1300hrs – 1330hrs</p>
Spectators, coaches and officials.	<p>Entry is free of charge for spectators, however, please remember this is a children's development event and it's about learning. Some of the refs and table officials will also be developing, so please bear with them. Remember children are watching your behaviour for examples how to behave.</p> <p>Seating is limited therefore be respectful of others and do not reserve with bags etc.</p> <p>There will be a tuck shop selling food and drinks throughout the day (cash only).</p> <p>If any over 11's would like to try their hand at timekeeping they would be welcome, competitions can't run without table officials and there is a real shortage throughout the country, so where better to try it out than at a development event, please speak with Rob on the day.</p>
Closing date	<p>Entries will be accepted up to Monday 24th March 2025 or before if full.</p> <p>Coaches please keep your eye on our Facebook page (www.facebook.com/HRJUDOCLUB) as we may request some late entries to fill categories or attempt to find a group for someone who has entered.</p>
Cost	<p>£25 – Early bird fee will be applied for entries received before 30th March: £20</p> <p>All participants will receive a medal.</p>
