Open to all British Judo and affiliated association members

Seniors aged 14+ years, orange to brown belt

Category 1: Men aged 14+ years – Orange to brown belt (not points scoring)

If numbers permit, this category may be split by grade

u55kg, u60kg, u66kg, u73kg *sponsored by Bedminster Judokwai*

u81kg, u90kg, +90kg *sponsored by Patchway Judo Club*

Category 2: Women aged 14+ years – Orange to brown belt (not points scoring)

u48kg, u52kg, u57kg, u63kg *sponsored by Patchway Judo Club*

u70kg, u78kg, +78kg *sponsored by Bedminster Judokwai*

If numbers permit, this category may be split by grade

The tournament director reserves the right to weight categories.

One gold, one silver and two bronze medals will be awarded per weight category.

Armlocks and strangles are permitted in all categories.

Those holding non-BJA grades should not hold grades below or above the colours stated.

Medals will be presented throughout the day as soon as categories have completed.

All players must provide their own white and blue belts!

Entry: £20 per player.

Ensure you enter the correct competition, as no entries/money will be transferrable.

Closing date: Sunday 16 November 2025, 11.59pm or sooner if entry is full.

No late entries will be accepted.

Weigh-in: There will be an open weigh-in, all players must present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judo bottoms plus t-shirt and footwear.
All players must have/wear a white judogi.
Ensure you bring your British Judo (affiliate) membership card (and that it is in date) and record book. If you do not have these, you will not be able to compete.
Please ensure you change in the changing rooms.
Footwear must be worn at all times when you are not on the mat.

Weigh-in times: Weigh-in times will be emailed out a week before the date of the competition.

Information: Spectators are free.
Car parking is free for 3 hours (you must enter your registration number into the console in the sports centre) or £5 for the day, payable at the leisure centre reception on entry. Please note the car park uses registration number plate detection to record your entry/leave times and there are parking enforcement cameras around the site.
