

Mike's Judo 3rd Annual Inter-School Judo Competition

Address: Haberdashers' Boys' School, Butterfly Lane, Elstree, Borehamwood, WD6 3AF

Date: Sunday 8th June 2025

This is a development event and open only to players graded Novice – 6th Mon only who attend Judo sessions at **school** only and have **not** received a medal at any of the following events British Minor Nationals, British National Schools, Regional Area/Open Event Medalists.

Eligibility:

Players must be aged between 6 years old and 12 years old
All players must have a valid British Judo License
All players MUST wear a WHITE JUDO GI
Female players MUST wear a white t-shirt under their WHITE JUDO GI
Arm Locks and Strangles are NOT permitted
BJA Technical Restrictions will apply

This tournament is **NOT** open to individuals who regularly compete in Red/Yellow Belt Rumbles, National Medalists, National Schools' Medalists and Regional Area Open Medallists.

Format:

Group 1 & 2 will be run in accordance with the BJA Judo Festival Guidelines.

Group 3 & 4 will be grouped into pools of 3/4/5 players of their weight, where possible, based on the their age, weight and coaches rating. However, some groups may need to be merged, and in these instances, it will be discussed with the Tournament Director and coaches of the affected players. All competitors will receive a medal.

Groups:

GROUP 1 – Females (aged 6 to 7 yrs on the day of the event)

GROUP 2 – Males (aged 6 to 7 yrs on the day of the event)

GROUP 3 – Females (aged 8 to 12 on the day of the event)

GROUP 4 – Males (aged 8 to 12 yrs on the day of the event)

Spectators Fee:

£4.00 per adult (to be paid on entrance the hall, please do not pay with the entry fee). Parents are welcome come along and support their child/children. Coaches will be allowed free entry on production of their valid accredited coaching pass.

Entry Information/Fee:

Entry fee is £25.00.

The entry fee is non-refundable unless the tournament is cancelled.

GROUP 2 (Boys aged 6 & 7) 10:30am to 10:45am
GROUP 2 (Boys aged 8 to 12). 12:15pm to 12:30pm

Start/finish times:

GROUP 1 & 3 (All girls) - Contests will begin at 9:45am approx (providing that all players arrive on time) and medals will be awarded once all the girls have competed, expected finish time 11am.

GROUP 2 (Boys aged 6 & 7) - Contests will begin at **11:15am** approx (providing that all players arrive on time) and medals will be awarded once all the boys have competed, expected finish time **12:15pm**.

GROUP 4 (Boys aged 8 to 12) - Contests will begin at **1pm** approx (providing that all players arrive on time) and medals will be awarded once all the boys have competed, expected finish time **2:30pm**.

Entries must be received no later than Friday 2nd May 2025.
