Competition Format	This is a British Judo Level Three event.			
	BJA rules will apply throughout the event and will be in accordance with the Tournament Handbook. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final.			
	The event intends to operate using a Compound Knockout format (repechage for bronze) where numbers permit. In the spirit of maximising development and positive experience, the organisers reserve the right to adapt the competition format (e.g., round-robin or pools) where appropriate, with the aim of ensuring each athlete has the opportunity to participate in multiple contests wherever possible. Please note the following:  Technical Restrictions will apply to all categories  No 30 second rule  Judogi measurements as per 2024 British Judo rules.  IJF Red label judogi rules or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be required at this event.  The wearing of both white judogi & blue judogi is not compulsory for this event. All competitors must have a white judogi available.
