<b>Competition Format:</b>	<p>This event is an age &amp; grade banded event as follows:</p> <p><b>Event 1 - Players under 12 - Novice to 6th Mon</b>  <b>(must be at least 8 years old on the day of the event)</b>          Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade &amp; weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.</p> <p><b>Event 2 - Players under 12 - 7th Mon to 15<sup>th</sup> Mon</b>  <b>(must be at least 8 years old on the day of the event)</b>          Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade &amp; weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.</p> <p><b>Event 3 - Players under 16 - Novice to 9th Mon</b>          Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade &amp; weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.</p> <p><b>Event 4 - Players under 16 - 10th Mon to 15<sup>th</sup> Mon</b>          Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade &amp; weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.</p> <p><b>Event 5 - Seniors (Players aged 14 &amp; above) Novice to 2nd Kyu</b>          Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade &amp; weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.</p>

	<p><b>Event 6 - Veterans (Players aged 35 &amp; above) Novice to 2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu</b></p> <p>Players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade &amp; weight with the aim to create meaningful contests and as many as possible.</p> <p>As tournament organiser and with the agreement of the players &amp; their coaches we reserve the right to combine the categories where necessary to provide our participants with meaningful contests.</p> <p>This tournament aims to provide players with as much mat time as possible allowing them to gain more experience of competitive judo. 1 Gold Medal, 1 Silver Medal &amp; 2 Bronze Medals will be awarded in all categories.</p>

Our double entry fee is £40.</p> <p>These entry fees are applicable for all entries posted &amp; paid for through our website on or before Saturday 8th November 2025. Any entries made after this date will be charged at our late entry fee price of £30 for single entries or £50 for double entries.</p> <p>We will accept entries on the day of the event of which our late entry fee of £30 will apply but payments must be made in cash.</p> <p>We will only stop taking entries for this event if it becomes oversubscribed. If over-subscription occurs we will post a notice</p>
<b>Weigh in:</b>	<p>Players can weigh for Event 1 from 9am and weigh In times for all other events will be released after the closing date once we know how many are in each group.</p> <p>All competitors <b>MUST</b> bring their <b>VALID</b> judo licence (BJA or affiliate) to registration and also their record book showing that they are at the grade in which they entered.</p> <p>All players will be weighed in Judogi pants &amp; t-shirt with 0.6kg allowance.</p>
<b>Spectators:</b>	<p>Entry Fee is £2 per adult paid cash on the day. Children are free and Coaches are free on presentation of a valid coaching card</p>
<b>Coaching:</b>	<p>Coaches will be allowed mat side throughout the day with a valid coaching pass.</p>
