Introduction

As many of you who have competed with us before will know, we attempt to create an inclusive environment for Judokas of all abilities. Please respect this and your fellow Judokas.

Format + age requirement

- Expected to be pools to knockout with repechage.
- Organisers reserve the right to change format depending on the number of entries. (ALL competitors will get at minimum 2 contests)
- The advanced team format is mixed teams, same as year. If there are incomplete Advanced Teams, organisers may be able to merge teams or add in individual competitors. There are likely to be teams entering without women, so any advanced women wishing to enter without a team should contact us and we will attempt to add you to a team
- Age requirement: in general, all judokas should be 16+. They should be aware it is an adult competition with strangles/armlocks. Preferably, the judoka should already have some competition experience - exceptions Groups A and C. Of course, we will try to put young people in groups with similar age.

Groups – Groups will be stuck to, when possible, but may be merged if low numbers in certain weights

Group A: Novice Women- 5th Kyu and Below (Players to be sorted into groups by age and weight)

Group B: Intermediate Women 4th-2nd Kyu (Players to be sorted into groups by age, weight and grade)

Group C: Novice Men- 5th Kyu and Below (Players to be sorted into groups by age and weight at tournament directors' discretion)

Group D: Intermediate Men- 4th to 2nd Kyu (U66 kg, U73 kg, U81 kg, U90 kg, O90 kg)

Group E (Team): Advanced Mixed (5 men, 3 women), Men (1st Kyu and Above) - U66 kg, U73 kg, U81 kg, U90 kg, O90 kg, Women (2 Kyu and Above) - U57 kg, U70kg, O70 kg

Entry Fees

- Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis (entry confirmed with payment)
- Entry limit of 225 will be strictly adhered to
- Entry cost is £22 per competitor. Any payments made after 7th February 2025 or on the day will be charged at £27 per competitor. An extra 10p is charged by the SU for online payments.

Weigh In

Weigh in will be ordered as per the schedule. If weigh in for a particular group finishes early, the next group may be called forward prior to scheduled time.

Competition will be due to begin at 9:30, with weigh-in times as below:

- Groups C (Novice): 8.50 - 9.20
- Groups D (Intermediate Men): 9.30 - 9.50
- Group A & B (All Women): 10.00 – 10.20
- Groups E (Mixed Team): 11.00 - 11.30

All competitors will weigh in in their judogi trousers and a plain t-shirt and will be given a 0.8 kg allowance.

Notes:

- All Judokas must wear a white judogi
- Coaches briefing regarding rules at 9:15
- All judokas must hold a valid BJA, BJC or AJA licence (or equivalent) and produce this when weighing in
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries or combine weight groups should this be required.
- Each club will be held responsible for the behaviour of its players
- In the event of a dispute, the Tournament Director's decision is final
- In the event of an on-mat dispute, the Referee in Charge's decision is final
- For advice on filling out the entry form see final page or email below
- In the event of a tie in the team event the method for how to decide a winner will be up to the tournament director and mat referees

2nd Kyu Women

- As a change from previous years 2nd Kyu Women will be able to enter the mixed team event. However, 2nd Kyu Men will be unable to join the team event. 2nd Kyu Women will be able to enter both the intermediate women and the mixed team for a discounted fee. Weigh in times for women participating in both events is the Group A&B slot, there is no need to weigh in again.
